

# Church Histories



## Pilgrim Baptist Church, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Pilgrim Baptist Church had its beginning in 1864 as a mission school, started by the Second German Baptist Church. Two years later, a second mission school was started. These two groups united, along with 94 members of the First German Baptist Church, and formed the "Second German Church of Baptized Believers." In February 1889, a building owned by the Moravian Brethren was purchased, and for 60 years the church continued its ministry in that location.

In 1897, Rev. William Kuhn, who had just graduated from our Rochester Seminary, became the pastor. The church started a mission school which soon became a part of the church. In the 1930's, the church began the switch from the use of German to the English language. The name of the church was changed to Pilgrim Baptist Church in 1943. In 1948, ground was broken for a new building. The first service was held in July of 1949 and construction progressed as money became available, and a service of dedication was held in 1952. During those years the Sunday School enrollment reached more than 300. In 1961, an educational unit was added. The church celebrated its 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 1974. From 1874 to 1984, twelve pastors faithfully served the church.


Architect's Plan of Proposed Church School/ Educational Unit of Pilgrim Baptist Church, 1961


